Vegetable Recipes

Spinach Feta Tortellini

Ingredients:

1 pound frozen cheese tortellini (or meat)
1 box chopped frozen spinach
Tomato, diced & seeded
3/4 ounces crumbled feta cheese
(tomato-basil or plain)
4 cloves garlic – crushed
4 tablespoons olive oil
Pignoli nuts (optional)
Salt & Pepper to taste

Method:

- ♥ Boil water for tortellini and cook until al dente.
- ♥ Thaw frozen spinach under running hot tap water in colander.
- ♥ Squeeze water out of spinach.
- ♥ Heat olive oil in skillet.
- ♥ Add garlic & spinach & pignoli nuts (if using) - sauté for approximately 4 minutes.
- ♥ Add feta cheese and tomato.
- ♥ Pour over drained tortellini and mix well.
- ♥ Makes 3 – 4 servings. Great with a bagged salad & bread.
- ♥ Can be reheated on very low heat in microwave – good cold, too!

Glazed Carrots

Ingredients:

1 can tomato soup
1/2 cup oil
3/4 cup vinegar
1 cup sugar
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon black pepper
1 teaspoon prepared mustard (dry)
1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
6 cups cooked carrots (about three pounds raw; cut into 1/4 inch circles)
1 medium green pepper; finely chopped
1 small onion; finely chopped

Method:

- ♥ Mix all ingredients ,except the carrots, together thoroughly.
- ♥ Add carrots
- ♥ Marinate in the refrigerator overnight
- ♥ Serve cold.
