## *Gift Card Rebate Program* *An Easy and Profitable Fundraiser!*

May 2, 2010, after a few planning and preparation months, our Court placed its first Gift Card Rebate Program order!

At the close of the Third Quarter, September 2010, an overall profit of \$2,597.09 has been raised!

Ten ordering weeks, a total of 30 unique patrons, \$2,597.09 in profit!

It can't get any easier ... although, with your help ... the profits can grow, and grow, and grow!

Please, purchase gift cards at our monthly meetings and/or place your orders regularly.

### *How our Gift Card Rebate Program Works ...*

- ♥ Three members of our Court invested a total of \$3,010.00 to our Gift Card Rebate Program. Thank you! These loans made it possible for our Gift Card Rebate Program to purchase gift cards at a discounted rate from local retailers such as Martin's Food/Pharmacy, Weis Markets, King's, and The Dream; all of whom have minimum ordering requirements and to have additional retailers: Giant Eagle, Walmart, Lands' End, Hoss's, and Sheetz available for Direct Sale purchase.
- ♥ At our monthly meeting, you can purchase gift cards for the items we stock: Giant Eagle (\$25 or \$100), Martin's Food/Pharmacy (\$25 or \$100), Weis Markets (\$25 or \$100), Sheetz (\$25), King's (\$10), Hoss's/Marzoni's (\$10 or \$25), The Dream (\$10), Lands' End (redeemable at Sears, Kmart, and land-send.com \$25), and Walmart (\$25).
- ♥ You can also submit a paid Order Form order, for items we do not stock, twice a month.
- ♥ Twice a month we combine the individual Order Form orders and Direct Sale purchases from our monthly meeting, into one primary order; our ordering schedule is on the front of the Order Form.
- ♥ After our deposit is made, our vendors are called with the number of gift cards we are ordering from them; we verify the net due (cost less the rebate) and the day we will be there to pick them up.
- ♥ A few days later, we visit our local vendors to pick up and pay for our order. As an example, if five people ordered a combined total of eight \$25.00 Jethro's gift cards, with a 15% rebate, when we picked up the eight gift cards at Jethro's, we would give them a check for \$170.00 (\$200.00 cost less \$30.00 rebate.) The profit is realized immediately! When you use the gift card, it is for the full face-value, in this case \$25.00. We also purchase gift cards from our primary vendor, Great Lakes Scrip Center, who electronically transfers the net due (the cost plus shipping minus the rebate) from our checking account after we call in our order and then ships our gift cards to us.
- ♥ During the ordering week, once all the orders are received, we fill the individual orders for pick up at our monthly meeting or if the order is placed at or after the meeting, we will give you a call to make specific pick up arrangements. Our group of eight dedicated volunteers are also willing and able to assist anyone in making other drop off or pick up arrangements. Their names and phone numbers are on the next page of this newsletter.
- ♥ According to the quarterly schedule on the Participation Agreement and how you chose to apply your rebates, disbursements of the rebates earned are made.

**By marking yes, you acknowledge you understand the following statements:**

- Yes  No 1) I will only use a check or money order to pay for my Order Form order purchase. I know cash is not accepted.
- Yes  No 2) I understand there is a limited return policy. Only those Gift Cards/Certificates able to be resold or returned to the vendor will be able to be returned. There may be fees associated with the return; if there are any fees, I will be responsible for the full cost of the return.
- Yes  No 3) I understand if my check is returned for insufficient funds, I will pay the full amount of the returned check plus a fee, payable to the CDA Gift Card Program; two or more returned checks will limit payment to money orders only.
- Yes  No 4) I understand rebates will be assigned according to how the second page of this PA is completed.
- Yes  No 5) This PA supersedes the Order Form, meaning once you have a PA on file, that information will be used, regardless of what the Order Form says. If you wish to change how your rebates are assigned, you will need to submit a new PA, with the limit of two PA per Calendar Year.
- Yes  No 6) The CDA Gift Card Program will operate its Fiscal Year on the "Calendar Year"; Fiscal Year and Calendar Year are synonymous.
- Yes  No 7) End-of-the Year Charitable Contribution Statements will be issued before January 31, for the previous Calendar Year.
- Yes  No 8) Quarterly Statements and rebate checks will be issued no later than 45 days after the end of the Fiscal Year Quarter. The First Quarter, January - March, would be issued no later than May 15; the Second Quarter, April - June, would be issued no later than August 15; the Third Quarter, July - September, would be issued no later than November 15; and, the Fourth Quarter, October - December, would be issued no later than January 15.

Catholic Daughters of the Americas, Court Prince Gallitzin #2625 (referred to herein as "we," "us" and "our") sponsors a Gift Card Program which allows you to purchase Gift Cards. The Gift Cards you purchase through our program generates rebates from the participating retailers. These rebates can be used as a Charitable Contribution to participating 501(c)(3) organizations or you can receive your rebates back in cash (For more information, see page one, number eight.)

It is your choice as to how you want to assign your rebates, after the 5% Administration Fee.
