We now meet in the conference room at burkeMICHAEL+. They are located at 833 Beech Avenue (Pittsburgh 15233).

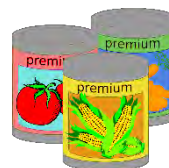

Food Insecurity, Part 2

In February's newsletter, we discussed food insecurity and how it affects more than 25% of the households in the Christ Our Savior Parish area. We know that many of the food insecure are elderly, disabled, or single mothers with children.

We also briefly introduced the resources available to help those who are food insecure. Since last month, our Court has investigated a few options available to us to help support our neighbors to ensure that they do not experience chronic hunger.

- Christ Our Savior parish has a food bank at the St. Cyril garage that distributes food on the 1st Monday following the 2nd Sunday of each month at 3:30 - 4:30 p.m. The parish's conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul supports the parish food bank with donations of food and money.
 - During Lent, our parish has food collection boxes in each church building. We encourage our members to donate to this collection.
 - We hope to organize an ongoing collection of food donations following Lent.
 - If you, or someone you know, needs additional food, please visit the food bank distribution.
- The parish's conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul also provides emergency grocery gift cards on a case-by-case basis for

individuals who cannot get to one of the food banks.

- During our last meeting, we discussed assisting with the grocery gift cards by either providing gift cards or cash to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. However, it will take a vote of our membership to make this type of donation.
- We encourage our members to also individually support the Society.
- Senior Boxes (Commodity Supplemental Food Program) are available for individuals aged 60 and over with incomes of less than 130 percent of the Federal Poverty Guideline; these boxes are distributed monthly through neighborhood sites. Contact Melody Geer for more info.
 - We have contacted Pittsburgh Food Bank about this program. Their greatest need is identifying homebound qualifying seniors (60 years of age or older and meet the income guidelines) and delivering the Senior Boxes to them.
 - We have contacted Mary Swindal (the parish's Pastoral Associate who is working with our seniors) about joining together to identify qualifying homebound seniors in our parish and ensuring they receive their Senior Boxes on a monthly basis. Discussions are on-going.

We pray to the Lord for:

- Softened hearts to show our love for our fellow man.
- An end to Abortion.
- The March intention of our Holy Father – Evangelization – We pray that the Church in China may persevere in its faithfulness to the Gospel and grow in unity.
- An increase of Vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

- For an increase of active members in CDA, especially our Court.
- For all those who are caught in the web of human trafficking.
- For our governing officials and their families.
